Supervisor Drozd opened Work Session.

1. Supervisor Drozd will be meeting with a grant writer and Deputy Village Mayor Kelly Baker on 5/23/26 to discuss possible grants to update Town Hall.
2. Penn Power came to the Senior Center to do the yearly generator check and service.
3. The M & T banking changes went through and Supervisor Drozd notified Kaufman Utz.
4. Wayne, Supervisor Drozd and Jeff from the Library got the shed at the library cleaned out. The old push mower is still there. Highway Supt. Heim is getting prices to purchase a small John Deere tractor with a leaf collection system for Wayne to use.
5. Aflac sent a check for \$379.08 for Sean Andrews' overcharges, so that matter is reconciled.
6. There will be AED and CPR training on 5/15/26 at the Senior Center for some Town employees.
7. Sales tax is going up. April was 4.54% higher for the second quarter than last quarter, 12.96% higher than last year's total.
8. The Erie County and McAndrew lab did the yearly and monthly water test at the park and it is fine.
9. The May abstract has a charge for the North Java fire company to replace all of the AED pads through their bid pricing, which was cheaper than getting them anywhere else.
10. The Town received letters from the Village and the Springville Fire Company in regards to a bonfire that the Springville Travelers Motorcycle Club had on April 25, 2026, which was during the NYS burn ban that was out of control. They would like the Town to step in to stop this annual occurrence. CEO Roberts is working on a citation.
11. Dean Tybor is working on the roof leaks at the highway garage.
